She wore clothes made of parachute and learnt to drive and never had a test (she still hasn't even had one and now its 2020 and she learnt to drive in the 1940's).

JOBS DURING THE WAR

My great gran was in the Women's Royal Air Force and what she did was this: there was a big map on a table and she moved pictures of planes about so then the R.A.F knew where to fly and where the planes were as they didn't have computers to show that in those days.

Great Grans husband died a long time ago BUT he was sent to Iceland during the war HE MET WINSTON CHURCHILL IN 1941 HERE IS THE PICTURE. He also took part in D-Day. He was in the same regiment as Captain Tom Moore but they were in different places.
